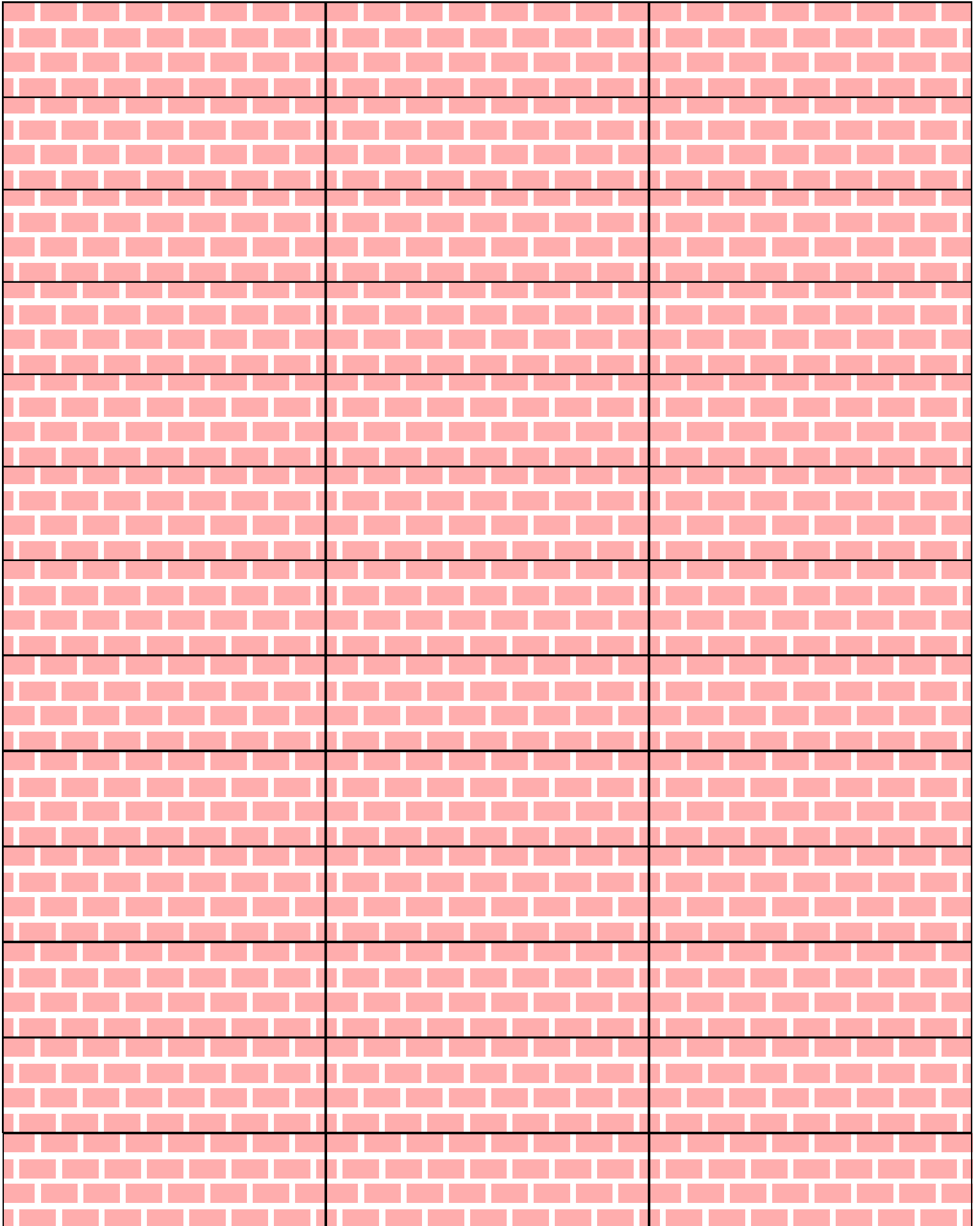

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GODLY CHARACTER TRAITS...

ALERTNESS The ability to anticipate right responses to that which is taking place around me.

BOLDNESS Confidence that what I have to say or do will result in lasting benefit.

CAREFULNESS Giving adequate thought to what one says or does.

CONTENTMENT Realizing God has provided everything I need for my present happiness.

ENCOURAGEMENT To instill courage, hope and confidence in another.

FAITH Visualizing what God intends to do in a given situation and acting in harmony with it.

FORGIVENESS Healing others by using their offenses as a means of expressing to them Christ's love.

FRIENDLINESS The ability to make another person feel comfortable in your presence.

GENEROSITY Realizing that all I have belongs to God and using it for His purposes.

GENTLENESS Expressing personal care appropriate to others emotional need.

GRATEFULNESS Expressing adequate appreciation for a service or favor freely rendered

HELPFULNESS To give or do what is needed or useful.

HONESTY Dealing with others in an open, fair, forthright manner.

HUMILITY Knowing God and others are responsible for the achievements in my life.

JOYFULNESS The praise of my inward being in genuine harmony with God and others.

KINDNESS Showing the extra generous, genuine sympathetic attitude or action toward others.

LOVE Seeking the good of others irrespective of our feelings.

OBEDIENCE Freedom to be creative under the protection of divinely appointed authority.

PATIENCE Accepting a difficult situation from God without giving Him a deadline to remove it.

POLITENESS Having and showing appropriate courtesy and consideration in any given situation.

RESPECTFULNESS Giving due esteem and honor to another.

GENESIS 11:1-9



¹ Now the whole world had one language and a common speech. ² As men moved eastward, ^[a] they found a plain in Shinar ^[b] and settled there.

³ They said to each other, "Come, let's make bricks and bake them thoroughly." They used brick instead of stone, and tar for mortar. ⁴ Then they said, "Come, let us build ourselves a city, with a tower that reaches to the heavens, so that we may make a name for ourselves and not be scattered over the face of the whole earth."

⁵ But the LORD came down to see the city and the tower that the men were building. ⁶ The LORD said, "If as one people speaking the same language they have begun to do this, then nothing they plan to do will be impossible for them. ⁷ Come, let us go down and confuse their language so they will not understand each other."

⁸ So the LORD scattered them from there over all the earth, and they stopped building the city. ⁹ That is why it was called Babel ^[c] —because there the LORD confused the language of the whole world. From there the LORD scattered them over the face of the whole earth.
